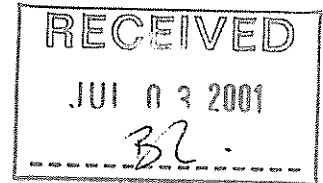

Thanks for the note. I am compiling information on mining companies in general and trying to keep up-to-speed on developments in the Arctic. So, I appreciate being on the distribution list.

As for WWF's involvement in the EA, it is unlikely that we will spend too much time on a particular case unless we believe that it has important policy implications. Also, our focus is on emphasizing up-front, proactive planning (including protected areas) as a companion to regulation and we hope to approach BHP, Diavik and De Beers on this matter. As the third diamond mine scheduled for operation in the North Slave, however, I want to monitor it so that I can suggest a course of action.
