De Beers expects delay in NWT project

South Africa's De Beers Consolidated Mines Ltd. told a diamond conference yesterday in Vancouver that delays in getting permit approvals for its \$260-million underground Snap Lake diamond project in the Northwest Territories could delay it for a year. De Beers estimates it will not achieve full production until the fourth quarter of 2005. It had hoped to begin production in 2004. As a result of delays in obtaining permits, the company does not expect it will be able to use the winter road in 2003 to move construction equipment to the site, a spokeswoman said. The mine is located about 220 kilometres northeast of Yellowknife.
