I am writing to express my concerns about the recent developments regarding the scheduling of the Prehearing Conference.

On October 10, 2002, I requested a definite date for the Prehearing Conference. I advised Mr. Azzolini that I needed to know the date in order to schedule a pressing matter on another file. In Mr. Azzolini's emails of October 11, 2002, he advised that he would make inquiries, however, he was not able to provide me with a definite date. I continued to hold the week of November 4, 2002 open but by October 17, 2002 a date for the Prehearing Conference still had not been set. On October 17, 2002, I contacted Susan Hunt and advised her of the urgency associated with scheduling the other matter. In response to my call, I received an email from Mr. Christensen dated October 17, 2002. That email advised that the earliest dates for the Prehearing conference would be November 8th or 13th, 2002.

In my reply email dated October 17, 2002 I indicated that, based on Mr. Christensen's advice, I had booked the other matter for November 5th and 6th, 2002. Although I held my schedule open until I received Mr. Christensen's email, I relied on his advice and proceeded to book the other matter.

I wish to stress that it is not possible for me to reschedule the other matter. It is also a tribunal hearing. However, in that matter I represent the tribunal itself and thus cannot request an adjournment. Further, the public notices regarding the hearing dates have already been sent out. The hearing will involve a large number of community members who have already been told about the hearing dates. The Board is also under a statutory obligation to hold that hearing before November 11, 2002. That hearing cannot be rescheduled without my client jeopardizing its jurisdiction.

On Wednesday, October 23, 2002, I received a voicemail message and an email indicating that the Prehearing Conference would proceed on November 5th and 6th, 2002. Under the circumstances, it would be impossible for me to attend a Prehearing Conference on November 5th and 6th, 2002.

My client has chosen to have legal representation at the Prehearing Conference. Indeed, there are a number of procedural and legal issues that require my involvement. I am extremely concerned that if the Prehearing Conference proceeds on a date prior to November 8, 2002, my client's rights to procedural fairness in this process will be seriously prejudiced.

I am therefore writing to formally request that the Board, in consideration of all of these circumstances, issue a ruling or direction that the Prehearing Conference be scheduled for a date on or after November 8, 2002.

Given the limited time available, I would appreciate an immediate answer in order that we can determine whether any further legal steps must be taken prior to November 5, 2002.

Thank you for your attention to this matter.
