Hello Fraser,

At this stage, De Beers will not provide hardcopies of Responses to Information Requests Round 1 (Second Round). A final version will be forthcoming (Week of July 22 or early in the week of July 29) with responses to the 20 or so outstanding questions from that round. Providing hard copies now would mean re-printing all of them upon release of the final version. De Beers has a strong desire to reduce the amount of paper usage in this EA process wherever possible and think that this is one opportunity to do so. We would prefer to rely on the distribution of electronic copies and are happy to provide further CD-ROMs for file or distribution purposes.
