**Re: Paramount Resources Ltd. Cameron Hills Application**

We have just received a document from Paramount Resources Ltd. which refers to the National Energy Board (the "NEB") having "granted approvals to Paramount to build a transborder pipeline." Specifically, it cites:

"NEB Section 5(1)(b) of COGOA Order EPO-01-2002," and


"NEB Section 58 Order XO-P097-02-2002"

We have not received notice of any approvals granted by the NEB, and do not know what the cited Orders refer to. We assume Paramount's letter must be in error, as the evidentiary record before the NEB regarding Paramount's pipeline gathering system is incomplete. Please see the letter from us, dated January 15, in which we wrote that the Ka'a' Gee Tu First Nation could not comply with your information request for comments on Paramount's traditional use study until late January. In this letter we asked you to inform us immediately if this arrangement posed any problems. The NEB did not respond to this letter. A copy of the requested information was supplied to the NEB on February 7, 2002, and we are awaiting your response.

Please advise immediately if the NEB has indeed issued project approvals to Paramount.  
If so, please provide copies of the approvals immediately.
