Subject: Consultations with regards to the WesternGeco proposed 2003 Mackenzie River Seismic Project.

Dear Laura.

Just writing to confirm the action points raised from our telephone conversation yesterday, with regards to the Proposed WesternGeco Mackenzie River 2-D Seismic Program. My understanding is that we have agreed to:

1. Deh Cho First Nations will organise a Deh Cho First Nations Group Leadership Meeting, where WesternGeco will present the Mackenzie River Acoustic Measuring, Fish Behavioural, Wildlife and Community Monitoring Results from our 2002 Test Program. To bring the leaders up to date with the Program Status and to discuss any issues or concerns.
2. WesternGeco will be in contact with the Band Councils in the communities of, Ft. Liard, Nahanni Butte, Ft. Simpson, Jean Marie River and Wrigley, to offer to meet with the Band Councils and Members of the Public to give a continuing up-date on the project and present the acoustic fish, wildlife and community monitoring program results.
3. WesternGeco will hold for the Deh Cho First Nations a workshop similar to the WesternGeco workshops held in Calgary on the 5th Dec, and in Yellowknife on the 12th Dec, to present the technical data from the WesternGeco Acoustic Measuring, Fish Behavioural, Wildlife and Community Monitoring Results.
4. We have agreed to meet to discuss benefits to the Deh Cho of the proposed seismic program.

Thank you very much for your time yesterday morning. I look forward to meeting with you to further discuss our proposed 2003 project.
