RE: NEB Decision to refer the WesternGeco Canada Limited Markenzie River 2D Selsmic Program 2002 to Environmental Assessment

Dear Mr. Christensen:

Pursuant to subsection 125(1) of the MVRMA, the National Energy Board (NEB), as the preliminary screener, has determined that the WesternGeco Canada Limited Mackenzie River 2D Seismic Program 2002 (the development) might have a significant adverse impact on the environment, and has referred the development to the MVEIRB for an environmental assessment by letter dated June 25, 2002.

This letter is to advise that the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, Fish Habitat Management – Western Arctic Area (DFO) concurs with all aspects of the June 25, 2002 letter sent to the MVEIRB by the NEB and that the referral to environmental assessment should be considered a joint referral by both the NEB and DFO.

Also, to reiterate NEB, DFO is of the opinion that a test program is critical for determining potential environmental effects, and anticipates that an appropriately designed test program would not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment. This information can be used in the environmental assessment of the proposed development. Upon receipt of a complete test program design from WesternGeco, DFO will review it in conjunction with RWED and NEB.
