

Re: Participant Comment Period for the Drybones/Wool Bay Developments – Consolidated Goldwin Ventures, North American General Resources Corp. and New Shoshoni Ventures

We are now entering the next phase of the Environmental Assessment for Drybones/Wool Bay developments. The participant comments phase is designed to encourage discussion among the parties focused on the Developer's Assessment Report(s).

All submissions should be sent to the Review Board for re-distribution. This step will ensure that the material is added on to the public registry and assigned a number to effectively track the discussion. The attachment will explain this part of the process to help you to participate effectively. Written comments must be received by the end of day Monday, September 2, 2003 to be considered as part of the Public Record. Please ensure you provide the following information for each submission:

- Party making submission;
- Date of submission;
- Analysis by topic (i.e., heritage, traditional land use, fish and wildlife, etc.):
  - Development(s) of concern for the chosen topic(s);
  - Section(s) of the Developer's Assessment Report(s) the concern relates to;
  - Questions about the topic, including the party you would like to respond; and,
  - Any other comments you would like the Review Board to consider.

The parties should have already received the final version of the Developer's Assessment Report. Revised Developer's Assessment Reports from Consolidated Goldwin Ventures and New Shoshoni Ventures arrived on August 15, 2003. For those of you on the distribution lists for Consolidated Goldwin Ventures and New Shoshoni Ventures, please ensure that you are reviewing the most recent report.

### PARTICIPANT COMMENT PERIOD

#### Purpose

Consolidated Goldwin Ventures, North American General Resources Corp. and New Shoshoni Ventures are being assessed through coordinated Environmental Assessment processes. There are two participant comment periods included in these Environmental Assessments. This first participant comment phase is intended to:

- Evaluate the adequacy and quality of the submissions for making good environmental assessment decisions; and
- Verify the scope of issues based on the Developers Assessment Reports provided by Consolidated Goldwin Ventures, North American General Resources Corporation and New Shoshoni Ventures.

### **Process**

Written communications between the parties will be distributed throughout this period and placed on the public registry. All parties may respond to comments submitted during this phase. Upon completion of the participant comment phase, the comments will be analyzed to identify issues for discussion at the pre-hearing conference. The pre-hearing conference will review outstanding issues and define a fair process for the public hearing. Presentations by developers at the public hearing will focus on unresolved issues.

# **Review Considerations**

This approach has not been used in Environmental Assessments conducted by the Review Board before. This document has been prepared to help the parties to prepare their submissions and to focus their review of the Developer's Assessment Reports.

The Review Board must make an Environmental Assessment decision for each of these developments. The parties should provide clear, specific and detailed comments for each development and where appropriate, comment on each development relative to all others for regional concerns. A single submission about all developments relevant to the parties is welcome but the comments should clearly indicate the development(s) to which each comment is directed.

Submissions that clearly outline comments, concerns and remaining questions will help the Review Board to finalize the scope of the Public Hearing. The final determination of the scope of the public hearing will be determined after the pre-hearing conference.

Some questions that you may wish to consider in your review of the Developer's Assessment Report are provided below. Other specific questions or comments may be based on your organization's role in land use planning and resource management. Please feel free to provide any other comments you may have that may need to be addressed by the Review Board.

- 1. Do you have any questions about the development, described in the Developer's Assessment Report, which limits your ability to evaluate the impact predictions and mitigations? If yes, please list them.
- 2. What is your confidence level in the impact predictions and mitigations put forward by the developer? Please explain.
- 3. Has the developer identified and considered all potential effects of the environment on the development? Please explain.
- 4. Do you have any evidence or knowledge that the Review Board should consider in evaluating the impact predictions and the effectiveness of the mitigation for potential impacts on...
  - subsistence and traditional land use?
  - fish and wildlife?
  - cultural and heritage resources?
- 5. Do you have any knowledge that may improve the proposed mitigation measures or the development overall?
- 6. Based on your review of the Developer's Assessment Reports, what remaining concerns do you have that should be addressed at the public hearing?
- 7. Please identify any remaining questions about, or comments on, the proposed development that are relevant to the environmental assessment.

## Limitation

The Final Terms of Reference and Work Plan for Consolidated Goldwin Ventures, North American General Resources Corporation and New Shoshoni Ventures did not include cumulative effects due to the need for a regional approach. The Developer's Assessment Reports do not explicitly address cumulative effects.

The Review Board commissioned a cumulative effects study as a resource to focus discussion on cumulative effects. The participant comment phase after the release of the cumulative effects study will clarify concerns about potential cumulative effects. The developer's formal submission on cumulative effects will consist of a response to the cumulative effects study at the public hearing.
