RE: Environmental Assessment Process for Consolidated Goldwin Ventures Inc. Diamond Exploration

The MVEIRB is similarly committed to an expeditious process. However the referral for Environmental Assessment (EA) requires a more rigorous review of the proposed mineral exploration program prior to permitting.

The scope of the Developer's Assessment Report and the schedule for the EA (i.e., duration of the public registry and decision date) is a component of the draft Terms of Reference and Workplan. The draft Terms of Reference and Workplan must be approved by the Board prior to release for comment. Consolidated Goldwin Ventures Inc. may present scheduling concerns for consideration by the Board during the comment period. The Board's decision regarding the issuance of the draft Terms of Reference and Workplan will be forthcoming at the end of May.
