Hi Kim,

The response from the Review Board mistakenly focuses just on the Paramount EA. The Paramount EA was used as the subject EA in DCFN's letter just because it is the only EA in the Deh Cho region currently at this stage - Report of EA released but not yet any response from the federal Minister and the NEB.

A closer read of the last paragraph shows that the letter is asking for general guidance on the application of Section 130 and 131 for all EAs, not just for the Paramount EA. It is not necessary to wait for a request for consultations on the Paramount EA when the information requested by DCFN applies to all EAs.
