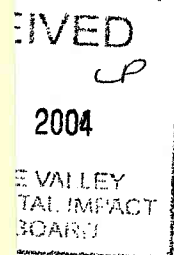

#### **Paramount Resources Ltd, Cameron Hills Pipeline Extension**

#### **Spill Procedures Submission.**

The Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) submitted a letter to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental impact Review Board (MVEIRB) on March 1, 2004. This letter was in response to MVEIRB Board questions at the Paramount Resources Ltd Cameron Hills Pipeline Extension Public Hearing regarding the NWT spill agreement. As an attachment to this letter the GNWT provided the Northwest Territories/Nunavut Spills Working Agreement (1999), Spill Line Contractor Procedures (2003).

The GNWT would request that the MVEIRB remove from the public registry Appendix A: Spill Line Contract/Operations specifically the Cost Sharing section of the Northwest Territories/Nunavut Spills Working Agreement (1999), and Appendix 1-A to 1-F and 2-A to 2-E of the Spill Line Contractor Procedures (2003) as both of these documents contain sensitive information that was released in error.
