I have been reviewing the DAR submitted to the Review Board for the winter geotechnical work.

In the Land Use Permit application, Imperial says that the borehole locations will be a maximum of 6 m \times 10 m and that the test pit locations will be a maximum of 6 m \times 15 m. However, in the DAR, the maximum sizes have increased to 10 m \times 10 m and 25 m \times 25 m, respectively.

Why have the clearing sizes for the boreholes and test pits been increased in the DAR from what was applied for in the LUP?
