Now that Imperial has submitted its responses to the Review Board's second round of Information Requests, parties should begin to prepare their technical reports. These reports provide the Review Board with parties' views on the impacts of the proposed geotechnical program. Detailed instructions on the format of the technical reports are attached. Please follow the format instructions. It is particularly important that each technical report be submitted with a one page non-technical summary of the key issues in the report. This summary must not exceed one page. The deadline for these reports is Friday, Nov. 26th, 2004.

The Review Board will hold a pre-hearing teleconference on Wednesday Nov. 24th, 2004. All parties in Yellowknife are encouraged to participate in person at the MVEIRB boardroom. The Review Board does not wish to delay the upcoming hearings in Trout Lake, Wrigley and Ft. Simpson. These are scheduled for Nov. 30 - Dec.2, 2004. In the interest of maintaining this schedule, the pre-hearing conference will be held before the submission date for the technical reports.
