Thank you for your letter of August 31, 2004, which was also addressed to my colleague, the Honourable Ethel Blondin-Andrew, Minister of State (Northern Development), in which you comment on the proposed expansion of the Nahanni National Park Reserve. I regret the delay in responding.

I recognize the importance of your concerns regarding the withdrawal of lands for park expansion. I would also like to assure you that officials with Indian and Northern Affairs Canada are continuing to work closely with affected Deh Cho First Nations and other partners to ensure that economic development proceeds in the Deh Cho territory within a sound environmental management framework.

Moreover, as a result of the *Deh Cho Interim Measures Agreement*, signed in May 2001, decisions regarding the management of lands and resources in the Deh Cho territory are made in consultation with the Deh Cho First Nations. With respect to mining and other possible developments in the Nahanni Butte region, I am confident that these decisions will reflect community concerns, as well as ensure the ecological integrity of this important region.

I have taken the liberty of providing the federal Minister responsible for national park expansion, the Honourable Stéphane Dion, Minister of the Environment, with a copy of your letter for his consideration.
