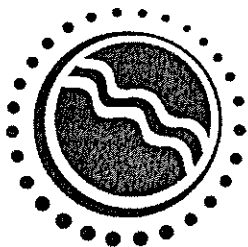

**Re: Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment – Ur-Energy Inc.-Screech Lake
(east of Great Slave Lake) Mineral Exploration.**

On May 3, 2005 the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board referred Ur-Energy Inc.'s proposed program at Screech Lake in the upper Thelon river watershed east of Great Slave Lake to Environmental Assessment, according to section 125 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act. The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board cited public concerns as reason for the referral.

Ur-Energy proposed development includes:

- drill five diamond exploratory holes
- temporary camp sites
- temporary fuel storage
- deposit of sewage and grey water

The Review Board will determine the scope of the project and of the assessment and provide draft terms of reference and a work plan. Organizations on the distribution list will be invited to comment on the draft Terms of Reference and Work Plan. At a later date they will be asked to identify which role, if any, they intend to play during the assessment.
