Subject: CGV and Sidon Maps

Hi Steve,

Dora asked me to re-send these maps to you. There are four maps in the CGV pdf file, and one in the Sidon jpg file (which is pretty big).

Here is a brief verbal synopsis of the locations of the programs, cut from an e-mail I sent out previously:

Sidon is a diamond exploration program located at the northwest corner of Defeat Lake. Sidon has applied to drill one to three holes.

CGV is a diamond exploration program over approximately six areas.

- One area is a small bay approximately halfway between Moose and Drybones Bays.
- Another area is called the FC claim, and includes a drill target in the northern part of Moose Bay, and two in the area of Moose Lake.
- The Moose Claim, north of Moose Lake, contains multiple drill targets.
- Another drill target (in an area known as the JJ Claim) is approximately five kilometers west of the north-east arm of Defeat Lake;
- An area called the Cleft Claim (north of Moose Bay and west of the southern end of defeat Lake) is another target area.
- The ZZL Claim is on the northeast branch of Zigzag Lake, and contains a drilling target.

CGV appears to want to drill one to three holes in each of the six areas.

Both programs have some common elements: Drill rigs need a ten by ten meter clearing. Most of the work will be supported by helicopter, but snow machine access is also proposed. A small camp, movable by helicopter, is proposed. The work would occur in winter, likely February to April. The exact locations of the drill holes cannot be known in advance, and may be on land or on lake ice.
