**Re: Tamerlane EA – Public Hearing and Information Requests**

Based on the Technical Session proceedings and Tamerlane's commitment to use an injection well in lieu of infiltration basin, the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (MVEIRB) is re-considering the need for a Public Hearing. Any party that is of the opinion that a public hearing is still required should advise the MVEIRB no later than August 7, 2007 and provide reasons why a hearing is required.

The MVEIRB is now entering the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of information requests. Parties to the EA are invited to identify additional requests they deem necessary to perform an analysis of the Developer's Assessment Report to assist MVEIRB in making its decision.

Information Requests may be directed at the developer or at any other party to the assessment. All requests must be submitted to and approved by the MVEIRB. Please submit your Information Requests at your earliest convenience but no later than August 7, 2007. The MVEIRB's standard format and explanation of terms for Information Requests is attached.
