Re: Draft agenda and hearing instructions

Following the discussions between Review Board staff and parties, the Review Board is issuing the attached draft hearing agenda for comment. Please note that it includes specific time limits based on what parties' representatives said they would need for each subject area. **Parties should respect their time limits** or risk interruption. A timer will be used.

In addition to providing parties with their requested times as well as possible, the draft agenda intentionally leaves longer periods for questioning for subjects where parties have indicated that additional time would be necessary.

For the first morning (Sept. 10 2012) only:

- At 9:45 am parties should be prepared to introduce their team during the questioning period following the developer's first presentation.
- Parties' position summaries at 10:40 are intended to be brief stand-alone presentations.
 Parties should use these to present summaries of their highest priority conclusions and recommendations. There will not be any questions following these.

Wednesday August 22, 2012 is the deadline for parties to submit their presentations to the public registry. The developer is required to submit its presentation outlines by Wednesday August 29th, 2012.

An audio webcast will be provided during the hearing. Remote participants will be able to listen to the proceedings and to follow presentations on our website. Parties' representatives in the hearing room may receive questions from remote participants, and may choose to raise these questions at the appropriate time. Parties are responsible for organizing this themselves. Board staff will not be able to do this on behalf of parties.

To help remote participants follow along, please **make sure that your slides are numbered** in your presentations, and remember to say what number slide you are on as you make your presentation.
