Dear Parties and Developer,

Re: Information Request Extension

On May 31, 2012, the Review Board received the developer's responses to its earlier information requests. June 8th was the deadline for parties' information requests. These responses included descriptions of changes to the proposed project. Many parties, including *Yellowknives Dene First Nation, North Slave Métis Alliance, Environment Canada, Environment of Natural Resources* and *Transport Canada* have indicated that five days between these two dates was insufficient time to let them review and draft appropriate information requests. These parties have requested extensions of the Review Board.

The Review Board has carefully considered the extension requests from the parties. Due to the inadequate response time and the changes to the Tyhee Gold Project indicated in the information responses, the Review Board is extending the IR submission date for parties to 5:00 pm on June 29, 2012. Parties that have submitted incomplete IRs now can use the time to submit their remaining requests.

Considering the significant changes to the proposed project design from the original project description and DAR, and the discrepancies between the DAR and IR information, the Review Board requires Tyhee Gold Corp. to produce an updated project description, to be submitted no later than its responses to the June 29th IR requests from the parties. This updated description should consolidate all the major changes to the original project. The document should make clear the project going forward.



The technical session will follow the developer's response to the IRs. The Review Board will only proceed with the technical session once the developer provides adequate responses and an updated project description. This will ensure that parties and Board have a clear understanding of the project, and will promote an efficient and effective technical session in which parties can participate in a fair and meaningful way.
