To comply with several action items received as part of the Jay Project Developer's Assessment Report review process, Dominion Diamond is pleased to submit the following documents to Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (MVEIRB) for the Public Registry:

- 2014 and 2015 Jay Project Baseline Hydrogeology Update
 - This document is being provided in response to Dominion Diamond's undertaking during the Project technical sessions on April 22, 2015 to submit a report summarizing the hydrogeology results of the 2014 and 2015 field programs and to make a qualitative assessment of these data (i.e., Technical Sessions Undertaking #6).
- Draft Revision #2 of Conceptual Wildlife Effects Monitoring Plan (WEMP) and Draft Revision #3 of Caribou Road Mitigation Plan (CRMP) for the Jay Project (included in Appendix B of the WEMP)
 - These documents are being provided in response to feedback received from the CRMP and WEMP Workshop, held in Yellowknife on June 25, 2015, as part of the regulatory and community engagement process.
 - Please note that these are initial drafts of the conceptual plans and are intended for feedback and discussion through the environmental assessment process for the Jay Project, but would be expected to be finalized during the Water Licence and Land Use permitting process for



the Project. These documents are not intended at this point to replace the existing Ekati Mine operational management and monitoring plans which follow a separate review process through the Wek'èezhì Land and Water Board.

In accordance to our commitment to provide information and responses in a timely manner, we look forward to address any further concerns through the remainder of the Jay Project Environmental Assessment review process.
