Hi Chuck.

I had a look at the agenda today – I'm interested in speaking as a member of the public, primarily about Caribou. Thus, I was hoping that there would be time after the sessions on the Tuesday (or the Wednesday for that matter) – being only loosely involved in the process and reviewing only some of the submitted materials, I think I would be able to better participate after the wildlife and caribou sessions have been completed. It's my intention to listen into the webcasts much as I can. A more focused and improved submission is the result – meaning that the Board doesn't have to listen to issues that are addressed and I have a greater context to speak from. That's better for the process.

I do note that there is time from 4:30-5:30 on both Tues and Weds. However, the earliest I can easily hope to be in the room is 5:15, leaving only a few minutes. If there were anyone else wishing to speak, I would be out of luck. Secondly, I'm sympathetic to the long day for the Board, staff and parties - I don't want to be keeping everyone.
