This is further to my letter of September 9, 2015, regarding your September 3, 2015, request for a progress report on environmental assessment measures for barren ground caribou on operating mines in the Northwest Territories.

On April 1, 2014, the Northwest Territories Devolution Agreement came into effect which transferred the jurisdiction and decision-making authority over most lands and resources from the Government of Canada to the Government of the Northwest Territories. On further review, we have confirmed that any relevant records and expertise that Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada may have possessed prior to April 1, 2014, have been transferred to the Government of the Northwest Territories as required by the Agreement. We are therefore not in a position to provide any additional information beyond what is now in the possession of the Government of the Northwest Territories.

The Government of the Northwest Territories has the mandate and possesses the expertise for managing barren ground caribou herds; therefore, they are the most appropriate party to respond to your request.

With respect to the assessment of the effectiveness of mitigation measures, the Board may wish to consult with the environmental monitoring agencies in the Northwest Territories given their ongoing role in monitoring the implementation of mitigation measures related to diamond mines.
