We report to our society members (the Tlicho Government, Yellowknives Dene First Nation, Lustel K'e Dene First Nation, North Slave Metis Alliance, Kitikmeot Inuit Association, GNWT, Canada and Dominion Diamond Ekati Corp.) and although our Directors are appointed by these members, once appointed we operate independently. Our Directors are experts in various fields such as wildlife, fisheries, groundwater, environmental assessment and related fields. We have extensive experience with and knowledge of environmental management at the Ekati Diamond Mine. We have a mandate to participate as an intervenor in regulatory and other legal processes respecting environmental matters. Our active participation in this proceeding wil help bring our experience and understanding of the Ekati Diamond Mine to this proceeding in the interest of ensuring sound environmental management.
