**Dominion Diamond Ekati Corporation Jay Project  
Environmental Assessment (EA1314-01) – Response to GNWT Undertakings**

At the September 14, 2015 public hearing in Yellowknife, the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) committed to responding to three undertakings.

The first undertaking directed to GNWT (Undertaking #3) was for the GNWT to provide examples of any inline incineration monitoring requirements in other jurisdictions. Attached with this letter is a table outlining the requirements from other Canadian provinces and territories, as well as the regulations and documents referenced in the table.

Undertaking #4 required the GNWT to provide an outline of the specific steps needed to complete new air quality regulatory tools. Attached is an outline of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources's process for developing regulations; this process would apply to the development of any air quality regulations.

Undertaking #5 was directed at Dominion Diamond to meet with the GNWT to discuss and attempt to reach consensus on the timeframes associated with incineration reporting and re-stack testing. I can confirm that a meeting took place on September 22, 2015 and that Dominion Diamond will report on the outcome to the Board and other parties.
