Good afternoon Chuck,

For the record, the Nahanni Butte Dene Band upon consulting with and obtaining approval from all ten resident Elders in the community, passed a Band Council Resolution to notify officials at Parks Canada that the whole of Canadian Zinc Corporation's proposed all-season access road to the Prairie Creek Mine should be subject to a Traditional Land Use Agreement (TLUA); see attached pdf copy.

Furthermore, we are inviting the Federal Government and Parks Canada to join us in the co-management of all commercial undertakings related to the proposed road within the Nahanni National Park 'Reserve' which would include baseline studies as determined by the Mackenzie Valley Review Board.

We are confident that a comprehensive TLUA will advance the proponent's application for development permits and lead to economic benefits for all people residing in the Dehcho region.




RE: Parks Canada

Whereas the Nahanni Butte Dene Band hereby confirms upon the Band Council consulting with and receiving the approval of the Elders as listed below, that Council will notify officials at Parks Canada that the whole of Canadian Zinc's proposed all-season access road to the Prairie Creek Mine should be subject to a Traditional Land Use Agreement (TLUA) with the Nahanni Butte Dene Band.


The (TLUA) currently being negotiated with Canadian Zinc Corporation<sup>15</sup> a co-management agreement of all future undertakings related to the all-season access road such as heritage studies, road surveying and environmental and wildlife monitoring.
