On behalf of the Nahanni Butte Dene Band, Chief & Council would like to comment on a document titled: <u>Supplementary fish habitat report 06 Sep 16 (undertaking #7)</u>. recently posted on the Review Board Web site.

The Review Board should be aware it is Band policy that **any** field work which includes environmental and wildlife monitoring including baseline studies on our Traditional Lands that is linked to the proposed All-Season Access Road must be co-managed by the NBDB. This also includes any other work or industrial activity being considered in the future on our Traditional Lands.

It is also our opinion that since Canadian Zinc Corporation has undertaken this field work without prior consultation and without a Band representative, then we must respectfully ask the Review Board to inform the Proponent that the technical studies from July 2016 onward should be redone to our satisfaction.
