Prairie Creek All Season Road Project, CanZinc

Re: Instructions on closing arguments

Public hearings for the Prairie Creek All Season Road took place from April 24-28, 2017. Transcripts from the hearings are on the public registry and hearing undertakings were received on May 10, 2017. Parties may now submit written closing arguments to the Review Board. Closing arguments are an opportunity for parties to:

- 1. update their positions and recommendations based on the discussions at the hearings or the contents of the undertakings; and
- 2. summarize the parties' final views of impacts and recommendations to the Review Board.

These arguments will be considered by the Review Board when making its determinations on the significance of impacts of the project and whether measures may or may not be required to mitigate any significant impacts. Written closing arguments must not contain any new evidence and must be based entirely on evidence already included on the public record.

If your position is that the project will likely result in significant adverse impacts, please review your list of recommendations and identify those you would like the Review Board to incorporate as measures. For each of the recommendations you would like the Review Board to incorporate as measures, please describe to the extent possible:

- 1) which specific impact(s) each recommendation is intended to mitigate;
- 2) how that impact would otherwise occur, based on evidence on the public record, or the lack of evidence to support conclusions that no impacts will occur; and
- 3) the characteristics of the impact (spatial extent, duration, magnitude, frequency, reversibility, and likelihood).

The due date for closing arguments from parties is **May 26, 2017.**



The due date for closing arguments from the developer is **June 5, 2017**.
