Thank you for your letter of March 2, 2001, regarding the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board's (MVEIRB) Report of Environmental Assessment on the Proposed Development of Sable, Pigeon and Beartooth Kimberlite Pipes dated February 7, 2001.

As you are aware, the responsible Ministers and I must consider the report of an environmental assessment and may agree where a recommendation is made under subparagraph 128 (1)(b)(ii) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*:

- (i) to adopt the recommendation or refer it back to the MVEIRB for further consideration, or
- (ii) after consulting the MVEIRB, to adopt the recommendation with modifications or reject it and order an environmental impact review of the proposal.

The responsible Ministers and I have reviewed the MVEIRB report. I have enclosed for your information, a copy of my April 12, 2001 letter to Mr. Gordon Lennie, Chair of the MVEIRB advising him of our decision. You will note that I also enclosed a copy of your March 2, 2001 letter for the board's information.
