## Re: Gahcho Kue Round Two Information Requests

There are several issues that the LKDFN believes require further explanation in order to ease our concerns with the proposed project. The following is a list of topics that should be included for review in the second round of information requests:

- Caribou impacts (including but not limited to impacts on migration routes)
- Monitoring Agency vs. Advisory Committee
- Long term cumulative effects analysis and changes to the environment over the life of the mine (differences from baseline)
- Reclamation and closure
- Community level socio-economic issues
- Traditional knowledge use in <u>design</u> of the project, including monitoring programs
- Downstream water quality monitoring and impacts
