Introduction

The Review Board is hosting a combination of in-person and online technical scoping meetings for the Pine Point Mine Project environmental assessment. The virtual aspect of these meetings will be hosted on Zoom. This document provides information about the technical scoping sessions, a draft agenda for the meeting, information on COVID-19 protocols for in-person participants, and tips and tricks for participating in virtual meetings.

Technical Scoping Meeting Overview

Technical scoping meetings are intended primarily for interested groups, government departments and members of the public. Meeting participants will be asked to identify and prioritize issues for the Review Board to focus on for the environmental assessment of the proposed Pine Point Mine Project. The Review Board will consider the views of all participants when setting the scope of the environmental assessment.

The technical scoping meetings will be hosted at the following dates and locations:

Scoping activities will consist of Q&A with the developer, followed by a facilitated discussion to identify and prioritize the issues that need to be considered in this environmental assessment. Representatives from Pine Point Mining Ltd. will be available during all scoping sessions to provide information about the project and answer questions. Pine Point Mining Limited

Appendix A: COVID-19 Protocol for in-person participants

- Every person attending the scoping session in person must adhere to the Review Board's screening protocol upon arrival. The screening is as follows:
 - O YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER THE MEETING ROOM IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO YOU:
 - 1. You traveled outside of the Northwest Territories in the past 14 days
 - 2. You have been in contact with someone who is suspected to have COVID-19
 - 3. Anyone in your household is isolating
 - 4. You have **one** of the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - New or worsening cough
 - Shortness of breath, or

5. You have **two** of the following symptoms;

- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache
- Body aches
- New loss or decrease in your sense of taste or smell
- Participants must wear masks. When participants are eating or drinking, they can remove masks, provided they are seated and at least two meters from others.
- Everyone attending in person must sign in and provide contact information, in case contract tracing is necessary later.
- Individually wrapped snacks will be provided. Coffee will be served by a venue staff member so attendees don't need to move around the room.






Appendix B- Virtual Meeting Tips

Make sure that your computer is connected to WiFi and has good internet speed. If possible, plug your computer directly into your modem.

A few minutes before the start, please **mute all notifications**: phone on mute, emails as well. **If you are experiencing a bad connection,** turn off your webcam by clicking on the Stop Video icon in the bottom left corner of the window. **Close all windows and tabs** except Zoom.

Please rename yourself in Zoom. Your name should be your full name and not a nickname. To do this, click on the three dots in the top right corner of your image in Zoom, as shown below. Click on Rename and type in your first and last names.




We expect that everyone will use their webcams; virtual meetings are more engaging when we can see each other. If you need to turn off your webcam, click on the **Stop Video** icon in the bottom left corner of the Zoom window.

Mute your mic when you are not speaking. Doing so helps cut down on background noise. To mute, click on the microphone icon on the bottom left corner of the Zoom window. To speak, either click on the same icon OR press and hold down your space bar.

During the meeting, you may need to take a break. **Don't click "Leave the Meeting."** Simply mute your mic and stop your video.





For great lighting, sit facing a window or a light, with the light behind your screen rather than with the light behind you.

Adjust your webcam so that people can see your eyes and not just your chin or forehead. Look into the webcam rather than down at it.

If your computer audio isn't working, switch to your phone for your audio. While you're in the Zoom meeting, click on the ^ to the right of the Mute button. Click on Switch to Phone Audio and dial the phone number above, using the Meeting ID, Participant ID, and passcode provided on the "Phone Call" screen.
