



Topic of Discussion: Alternative Fish Habitat Compensation if dikes are not reconnected with Lac de Gras.	
<p>Summary of Discussion: DDMI’s discussion with DFO focused on potential fish habitat compensation requirements in a scenario where the pits/mine workings are not reconnected to Lac de Gras after project closure.</p> <p>The following were the meeting outcomes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ DFO is receptive to considering alternative Offsetting approaches, including community-supported off-site fish habitat enhancement initiatives, to meet the requirements of its No Net Loss Policy. ▪ DFO expects that there are alternative off-setting approaches that can be reasonably/practically completed as off-setting if there is a decision to not reconnect the pit lakes with Lac de Gras. ▪ DFO acknowledged that it has yet to identify specific fish habitat compensation/offsetting requirements/expectations under a scenario where the pits/mine workings are not reconnected to Lac de Gras after closure. ▪ DFO acknowledged they have previously accepted the predicted pit lake water quality for A418 with deposition of processed kimberlite for the purpose of authorizing commencement of habitat construction work.
