


The Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation request an extension of two weeks to give time for our community to review and respond to Paramount Resources Water License Application MV2000L1-0009.

Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation is the primary community of impact that is situated closest to Cameron Hills. We are seriously concerned of the existing land use activities and proposed operations by Paramount Resources. There already exist forest-harvesting activities that have not been rationalized by an extensive timber inventory and analysis to ensure sustainable development. We are further gravely concerned of the proposed development by Paramount Resources on possible effects on the watershed that flow into Tathlina and Kakisa Lakes and onto the Mackenzie River.

Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation will play a lead role on this matter on behalf of the other affected communities. The Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation is working closely with the Deh Gah Goh'e First Nation, West Point First Nation and the Kall'odeeche First Nation to coordinate a response to the Water License Application MV2000L1-0009.
