Reference is made to Grand Chief Nadli's letter of this date requesting an extension of two weeks to give time to our communities to respond to Paramount Resources Water License Application cited above.


As expressed by Chief Nadli we are concerned about past and present land use activities along with the proposed development plans by Paramount in the Cameron Hills area of the Deh Cho region. We are specifically concerned with the timber harvesting operations and further development activities that may impact sustainable levels of timber along with the ecology and affected watersheds.

At this time we also make reference to a letter of this date signed by the Chiefs of Fort Providence, Kakisa, West Point, and the Hay River Reserve seeking a two week extension. We also request a two week extension on the above to allow for more time for Fort Providence to respond to Paramount's Water License Application MV2000L1-0009. This two week extension should allow for more time for our respective communities to consider the implications of the proposed water license.
