

#### 31 (1) (a) - Location and Area

- 1. The Permittee shall not conduct this land PLANS use operation on any lands not designated in the accepted application, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Engineer.
- 2. The Permittee shall remove from Territorial REMOVE Lands, all scrap metal, discarded machinery WASTE and parts, barrels and kegs, buildings and MATERIAL building material.

## 31 (1) (b) - Time

- The Permittee's Field Supervisor shall CONTACT contact or meet with a land use inspector INSPECTOR at the Fort Simpson office of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development, Phone Number (867) 874-6995, at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of this land use use operation.
- 4. The Permittee shall advise a land use REPORTS inspector at least 5 days prior to the BEFORE completion of the land use operation of REMOVAL (a) his plan for removal or storage of equipment and materials, and (b) when final clean-up and restoration of the lands used will be completed.
- 5. The Permittee shall not conduct any overland movement of equipment and vehicles
  after 0800 hours local time on April 1
  unless otherwise authorized in writing
  by a Land Use Inspector.
- 6. The Engineer for the purpose of this SPRING operation designates April 1, as spring BREAK-UP break-up.

7. The Permittee shall remove all snow fills REMOVE from stream crossings prior to spring SNOW break-up or completion of the land use FILLS operation unless otherwise approved in writing by a Land Use Inspector.

8. The Permittee shall complete all clean-up CLEAN-UP and restoration of the lands used prior to the expiry date of this permit.

9. The Permittee shall use a forced-air fuel- INCINERATORS fired incinerator to incinerate all combustible garbage and debris.

10. The Permittee shall keep all garbage and GARBAGE debris in a covered metal container until CONTAINERS disposed of.

### 31 (1) (e) - Type, Location, Capacity and Operation of Facilities

11. The Permitee shall backfill and restore BACKFILL camps sumps within two weeks following CAMP camp shutdown or removal, which ever SUMPS comes first, unless otherwise authorized by a land use inspector.

# 31 (1) (f) - Control or Prevention of Flooding, Erosion and Subsidence of Land

12. The Permittee shall remove any obstruction NATURAL to natural drainage caused by any part of DRAINAGE this land use operation.

13. The Permit tee shall not use any material SNOW other than snow in the construction of FILLS snow fills.

14. The Permittee shall suspend overland travel SUSPEND of equipment or vehicles if rutting occurs. OVERLAND TRAVEL

The Permittee shall establish vegetation 15. REVEGETATE on all areas stripped to mineral soil STRIPPED during this land use operation to a AREA minimum of seventy (70) per cent ground cover unless otherwise authorized in writing by a land use inspector. This vegetation shall consist of a forestry mix grass seed and will be accompanied by the appropriate fertilizer. 16. The Permittee shall save the organic soil SAVE stripped from the excavation area. 24. The Permittee shall report all spills REPORT immediately in accordance with instructions CHEMICAL contained in "Spill Report" form N.W.T. AND 1752/0593 to the twenty-four (24) hour PETROLEUM spill report line (403)920-8130. SPILLS

#### 31 (1) (j) - Security Deposit

25. The Permittee shall deposit with the Minister a security deposit in the amount of \$25,000.00 pursuant to Section 36 of the Territorial Land Use Regulations.

#### 31 (1) (k) - Petroleum Fuel Storage

The Permittee shall not place any petroleum 26. FUEL fuel storage containers within twelve (12) BY metres of the normal high water mark of any stream.

STREAM

27. The Permittee shall not allow petroleum products to spread to surrounding lands or into water bodies.

FUEL CONTAINMENT

28. The Permittee shall construct a dyke around each stationary fuel container or group of stationary fuel containers where any one container has a capacity exceeding 4,000 litres.

DYKE FUEL CONTAINERS

29. The volume of the dyked area shall be 10% greater than the capacity of the largest fuel container placed therein.

CAPACITY

30. The Permittee shall ensure that the dyke and the area enclosed by the dyke shall be impermeable to petroleum products at all times.

IMPERMEABLE DYKE

# 31 (1) (m) - Matters Not Inconsistent with the Regulations

- 31. The Permittee shall keep on hand, at all COPY OF times during this Land Use Operation, PERMIT a copy of the Land Use Permit.
- 32. The Permittee shall provide in writing to IDENTIFY the Engineer, at least forty-eight (48) AGENT hours prior to commencement of this land use operation, the following information:
  - (a) person, or persons, in charge of the field operation to whom notices, orders, and reports may be served;
  - (b) alternates;

- (c) all the indirect methods for contacting
   the above person(s).
- 33. The Permittee shall, while preparing the TRAPS access road, make every effort to avoid PROTECTION covering or destroying traps or snares that may be found along these routes.
- 34. The Permittee shall restore any trails used TRAILS by trappers or hunters along access routes RESTORATION by slashing any and all trees that may fall across these paths or trails and by removing any other obstructions such as snow piles or debris that may be pushed across the trails.
