Subject: Cameron Hills Forestry Activity

Hi Joe,

Most of the forestry activity that has occurred in the past has been along the east slope of the Cameron Hills, mostly at the base of the hill and slightly up the slope. There has been harvesting from the Alberta border, to about half way north along the east slope of the hills. Any further activity will likely progress northward along the east slope, possibly around the corner onto the north slope of the hills. At the present time there is no access to the north slope and therefore harvesting is not economical. There has been no harvesting activity on the plateau of the Cameron Hills, and likely won't be, since it is mostly swampy, unproductive land with few merchantable trees.

I will send you a map of where the cutblocks are and will look for a digital coverage of the cutblocks. If you have any more questions, please call.
