Hello Alistair and Mary:

Thank you for the summary notes from the "Responsible Minister's, the National Energy Board and Review Board's staff meeting", held on Monday, January 24th, 2005, on the modifications to measures for the Paramount EA.

Measures R2 to R12 can be provided to the Review Board members for further discussion as written or as modified by the NEB.

The RMs suggest the follow revised wording for R15, which is as follows:

The Review Board recommends that Paramount commit, in a letter to the Parties to the EA, to compensate the KTFN and other affected Aboriginal Groups for any direct wildlife and resource harvesting equipment losses suffered as a result of project activities, and to consider indirect losses on a case by case basis.

The RMs need to consider R13 and R16 further and will provide suggestions for comments to you as soon as possible.
