The Review Board had committed to providing directions on procedure to the communities on how this consultation process would occur. The Review Board proceeding with these discussions without even informing the communities that such discussions were taking place creates an unfair, biased process. The Review Board seems to be in a big rush that would effectively squeeze out the communities. Proceeding with this meeting next week would not be in the best interests of anyone involved in this process and could result in some substantial delays if the communities are required to take steps to protect their aboriginal and treaty rights.
