To clarify, although you may have recently received our discussion paper, it is merely a document we chose to distribute prior to the Aug 13 meeting to assist the participants in developing additional thoughts regarding the cumulative effects approach to the EA. As each of you have already had an opportunity to provide your input into the development of the Terms of Reference which clearly outlines the cumulative effects assessment requirements, we anticipated that each of you would have already given the matter considerable thought.
