

We, of the West Point First Nation, fully support the Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation at the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board's Public Hearings on Paramount Resources. The proposed Paramount Resources development in the Cameron Hills area has significant negative implications for Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation.

This development will result in significant adverse environmental and social impacts in the region, most significant for Ka'a'gee Tu First Nation.
