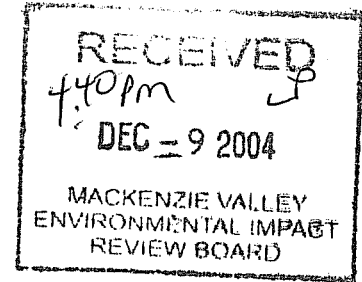

Re: EA03-005 Paramount Resources Ltd.'s Cameron Hill Extension EA

The Ka'a'Gee Tu First Nation (Ka'a'Gee Tu) is aware that both the National Energy Board (NEB) and the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) has proposed modifications to the Review Board's recommended measures in the Report of EA for the above-noted project. INAC and the NEB have also both requested consultations with the Review Board on their modified measures under Sections 130(1)(b)(ii) and 131(1)(b), respectively, of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA)*.

The Ka'a'Gee Tu are concerned that the only Dehcho member of the Review Board, Percy Hardisty, has taken a leave of absence from the Review Board to participate as a member of the Joint Review Panel for the Mackenzie Gas Project.

Mr. Hardisty heard the Ka'a'Gee Tu's concerns about this project first-hand during public hearings in Kakisa and Hay River and participated in the Review Board's decision process that produced the Report of EA. Given his participation in this file thus far, the Ka'a'Gee Tu believe that the integrity of a fair process, sensitive to aboriginal perspectives, would be maintained and assured if Mr. Hardisty also participated in the post-Report of EA consultation period with INAC and the NEB.

The Ka'a'Gee Tu are requesting that the Review Board temporarily set aside Mr. Hardisty's leave of absence to allow him to participate in the post-Report of EA consultation process and any other remaining Review Board processes or decisions concerning this project.
