

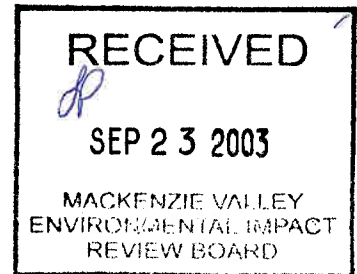

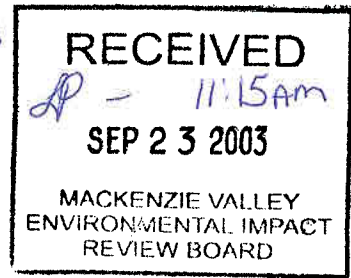

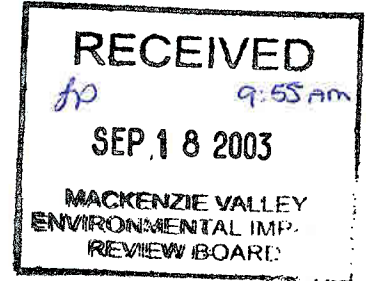

Paramount Resources Ltd. ("Paramount") is submitting the attached Developer's Assessment Report ("DAR") in response to the Terms of Reference and Workplan for the Paramount Cameron Hills Extension dated August 8, 2003.

The cumulative effects assessment compares environmental components at four discrete points in time:

- 1) Environmental Setting: the condition of the study area in 1960 before oil and gas activity commenced in the area.
- 2) Baseline Case: includes, without limitation, all completed and permitted activities in the study area.
- 3) Application Case: the current application that triggered this environmental assessment (5 wells and associated gathering facilities).
- 4) Planned Development Case: assesses the expected condition of the study area incorporating a 48 well development and production plan.

As was indicated in our prior applications, the magnitude of the environmental impact based on surface disturbance from the Environmental Setting through the Baseline Case is only 2% of the study area and through the Application Case increased an additional 0.1%. The incremental surface disturbance through the implementation of the Planned Development Case is also 0.1% for a combined total of 2.2%, of which 2% is already permitted.


Paramount and our partner are keenly interested in proceeding through the regulatory process. This is to provide a pace of development that meets Paramount's expectations, and those of the local businesses and citizens who have invested in equipment and training, and who are relying on having the opportunity to work this upcoming season.
