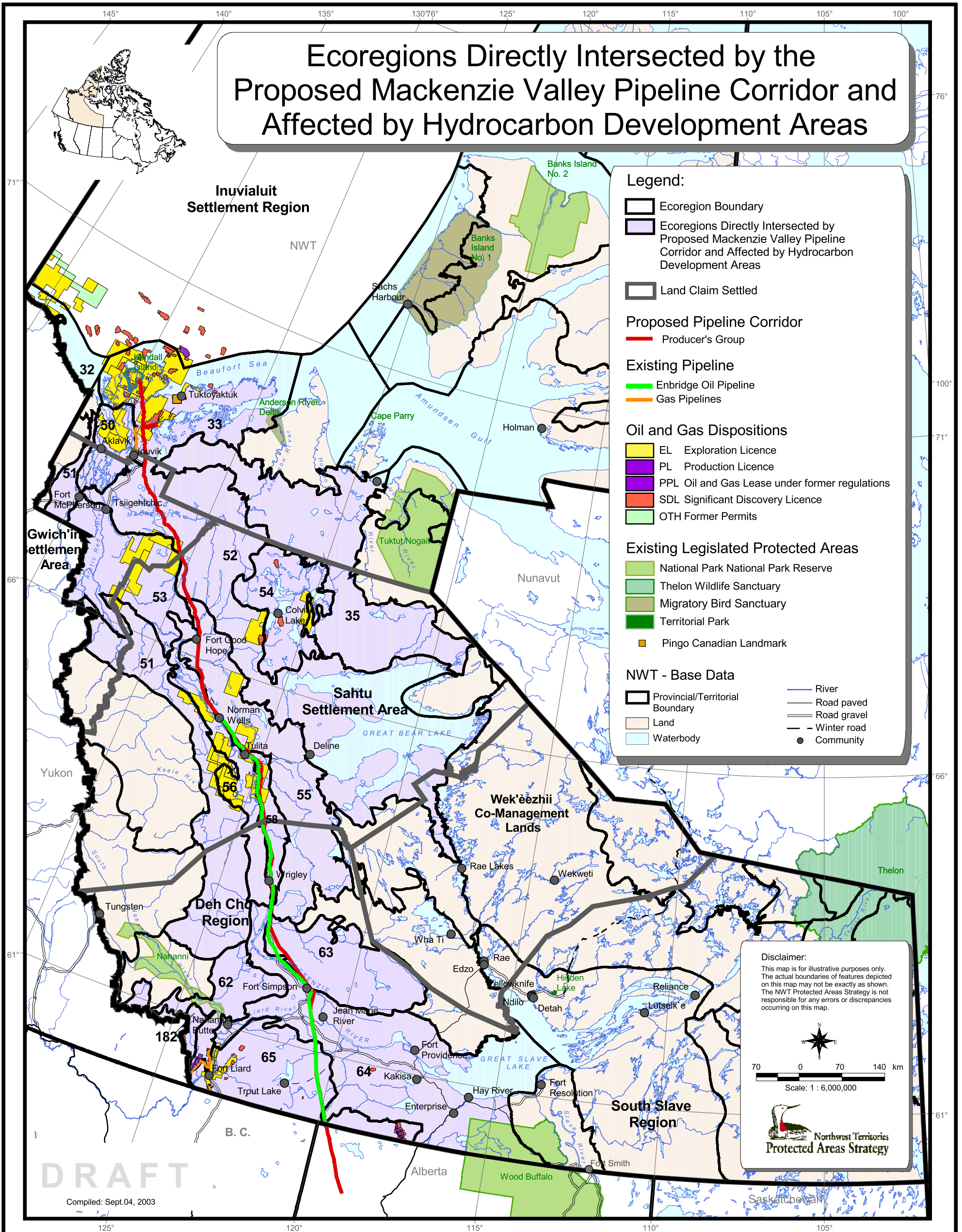


Ecoregions Directly Intersected by the Proposed Mackenzie Valley Pipeline Corridor and Affected by Hydrocarbon Development Areas
