Re: Inuvik Public Hearing for Mackenzie Gas Project Environmental Assessment

The Work Plan for phase one of the Mackenzie Gas Project Environmental Assessment includes hearings in Inuvik during the week of March 29. Please note that the following hearing dates and times have been set:

Tuesday March 30 from 2 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Wednesday March 31 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and

Thursday April 1 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

These times are subject to change. The hearings will take place in at the Midnight Sun Recreation Centre in Inuvik. Hearings are also held in Norman Wells March 16 to 18 and in Fort Simpson April 14 to 16.

All hearings will be conducted as community hearings under the Review Board's Rules of Procedures. Community hearings are meant to be informal, non-technical meetings to hear the views of potentially affected communities. Members of the public and community organizations are not required to pre-register.

Directly affected parties or interveners wishing to make a formal presentation during the hearing are asked to notify the Review Board of their intention as soon as possible and to submit a summary of their presentation to the Review Board no more than 7 days prior to the start of the hearing.
