

As the Federal Minister, and on behalf of the other Responsible Ministers with jurisdiction related to this development (the Government of the Northwest Territories, as represented by Environment and Natural Resources, Fisheries and Oceans Canada, and Environment Canada), I am writing to convey our decision on the recommendation contained in the Report of Environmental Assessment and Reasons for Decision for the Imperial Oil Resources Ventures Limited's Deh Cho Geotechnical Program, submitted February 18, 2005.
