## Response:

- Environmental protection measures for seismic programs are typically added as conditions to a
  Land Use Permit or Water Licence. The NEB inspections focus primarily on safety concerns. In
  practice, when the NEB Inspector encounters a potential environmental concern with a seismic
  program, the Inspector informs the local INAC Resource Management Officer or Water
  Resources Officer. The NEB has no specific process for informing or involving the KTFN with
  regards to environmental problems. However, a company regulated by the NEB, may decide to
  keep local community members informed.
- 2. The NEB is not aware of any previous NEB environmental inspection reports of Paramount seismic programs in the NWT.
- 3. The NEB is not aware of any NEB environmental orders or instructions that were issued to Paramount for seismic programs.
- 4. The NEB is not aware of any outstanding environmental concerns with previous Paramount seismic programs.
