Re: Environmental Assessment EA0506-007: Paramount SDL-8 2-D Geophysical Program

On November 23, 2005 the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development referred a proposed 2-D seismic program in the southern NWT to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an Environmental Assessment pursuant to section 126 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act. The developer is Paramount Resources of Calgary, AB. The development is referred to as "*Paramount Significant Discovery Licence (SDL) Eight 2-D Geophysical Program*"

Paramount proposes a 42 kilometer seismic program consisting of 7 lines with a line spacing of approximately 500 metres. The proposed development is located on Significant Discovery Licence 8, just north of the Alberta-NWT border, approximately 6 kilometres west of the Mackenzie Highway. Access to the site may be from the Indian Cabins area. For a full description please see the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board's web site:
