

PRESENTATION POINTS COMMUNITY SCOPING HEARING Gahcho Kue Diamond Mine

April 28, 2006 Yellowknife, NT

The following are the presentation points for the NWT Metis Nation and the Fort Resolution Metis Council:

- Presentation of Metis traditional knowledge and useage for the Kennaday Lake area by Ft. Resolution Metis Council President Lloyd Cardinal and Vice President Arthur Beck.
- 2. The lack of consultation in the whole process by DeBeers Canada.
- 3. Would like to see discussion opened with the NWT Metis Nation on an Impact Benefit Agreement and to be a participant in the development of the mine through economic opportunities.
- 4. The NWT Metis Nation would like to see a study done on the cumulative effects on the water, wildlife, air and land. DeBeers will be the only company who may potentially have two diamond mines in such close proximity that this would be a perfect project for this type of work and would be extremely beneficial to current and any potential further development.
- 5. There has been a clear lack of Traditional Knowledge brought forth by DeBeers as a part of this project.
- 6. There is a need for further clarity on the reclamation of the three proposed pits.
