On Wednesday, May 9, 2007 the Deninu Kue First Nation and Tamerlane Ventures Inc. signed an Exploration Agreement in which the Deninu Kue First Nation agreed to provide a letter of support to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board and the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board once certain conditions were met.

The Deninu Kue First Nation hereby indicates its support to the advanced mineral exploration (bulk sample extraction only) as described in Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board permit number EA0607-002 To be clear, the Deninu Kue First Nation does not consent to or lend its support for any exploration, mining or other activities beyond those described in the above mentioned permit.

Furthermore, the Deninu Kue First Nation has not been consulted with respect to any further activities of Tamerlane Ventures Inc. in the traditional territory of the Deninu Kue First Nation, and its interests have not been accommodated with respect to the same. Accordingly, Tamerlane Ventures Inc. must consult with and accommodate the interests of the Deninu Kue First Nation with respect to any further exploration or mining activities in the traditional territory of the Deninu Kue First Nation before those activities commence.
