The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) met in Yellowknife on June 19, 2007, to discuss, among other things, granting of party status for organizations wishing to become parties to the environmental assessment (EA) of Tamerlane Ventures Inc's. proposed Pine Point Pilot Project, an underground mine at the R-190 site in the South Slave.

The following organizations were subsequently granted party status by the Review Board:
