Re: Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment – Bayswater Uranium Corporation, Crab Lake, Dubawnt River Watershed, Thelon Basin

You are hereby notified that the above noted proposed mineral exploration program ("Crab Lake", MVLWB file number MV2007C0009) by Bayswater Uranium Corporation has been referred to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board ("Review Board") for environmental assessment, pursuant to section 125(1) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* ("MVRMA"). The Crab Lake project was referred to the Review Board by the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board on August 24, 2007, on the basis that the development might be a cause of public concern. This referral was received by the Review Board on August 27, 2007, and this proposed development is now under environmental assessment, as required by section 126(1) of the MVRMA.

As per the requirements of MVRMA s.118(1), no license, permit or other authorization for the carrying out of this development may be issued under any federal or territorial law until the completion of the environmental assessment.

The Review Board will create a public registry for this file, where all pertinent information will be held. The public registry will be available online at www.mveirb.nt.ca/registry. Details of the environmental assessment process are described in the Review Board's Environmental Impact Assessment Guidelines, available online at www.mveirb.nt.ca.

The Review Board will determine the scope of the development and scope of assessment in consultation with interested parties (including Bayswater Uranium Corporation) and will provide your company with Terms of Reference and a Work Plan for the environmental assessment.
